Rear Admiral Joseph Scott Walker, USN (Ret) November 28, 1942 – December 18, 2007

Real Admiral Walker passed away on December 18, 2007 with an eight-year battle with melanoma. During his naval career, RADM Walker first enlisted into the U.S. Navy as a Reserve Officer Candidate and was commissioned as an Ensign in the Navy Reserve in June 1965. His first duty station was Surface Warfare Officer onboard the USS *Vancouver*, and later he received the designation as a Navy Aviator.

Further along his career, he managed to command various Helicopter Anti-Submarine Warfare Squadrons, NAS North Island, California and different Navy Regions. But his most precious command was that of being a wonderful son to Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Walker, being a loving husband to his wife Marnie and loving father to his son Joe and daughter Kelly. And he spent precious moments spoiling his grandchildren Morgan and Tanner.
