USN (Ret.) August 24, 1946 - September 8, 2017 Lynd LaCroix Fitzgerald was born in Rochester, Minnesota on August 24, 1946. After graduating from high school, Lynd received his undergraduate degree from Northern Arizona University in Flagstaff, Arizona. During Freshman Orientation Week at NAU, Fitz met his forever love, Kathy Goacher. They were married in 1967 and would have celebrated their 50th Wedding Anniversary December 29th of this year.

Upon graduation from NAU, Fitz received his "Wings of Gold", completing Aviation Officer Candidate School. In 1970, the Fitzgeralds were assigned to San Diego, California, attached to the air wing on various U.S. Aircraft Carriers in the Western Pacific. In 1988, Captain Fitzgerald took command of the Helicopter Antisubmarine Squadron as Commanding Officer out of NAS Jacksonville, Florida. On to the U.S. Naval War College in Newport, Rhode Island, Lynd received double Master's Degrees. Captain Fitzgerald then served as Deputy Inspector General, U.S. Space Command in Colorado Springs. Prior to his retirement from the USN in 1994, Lynd served on the Commander-in-Chief Pacific Fleet Staff in Honolulu, Hawaii.

After retirement from the U.S. Navy, Lynd became a Senior Consultant with Injoy Stewardship Services in Atlanta, Georgia under the leadership of John C. Maxwell. While with ISS, Lynd advised and taught Biblical Stewardship, debt retirement, and capital improvements for churches across the country.

In 2001, Lynd and Kathy moved to Lynd's childhood family lake property in North Central Minnesota to discover what God had next for them. While living on the lake, Lynd served as General Manager of Lakewood Builders. They remained there until 2005, when they returned to their current home in the Springs.

Lynd and Kathy have a daughter, Shannon, married to Brad Swim of Parker, Colorado. Their children are son, Mitchell, a senior at Colorado Christian University; daughter, Erica, a sophomore at Colorado Christian; and daughter, Anna, a freshman at University of Colorado, Colorado Springs. Lynd and Kathy's son, Mark Fitzgerald, along with his wife, Deanne, live in Castle Rock, Colorado with sons, Cameron, a junior in high school, and Jake, in 8th grade. Lynd was fiercely devoted to his kids and grandkids.
