Captain Ryan Carron graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1994 with a Bachelor of Economics and was designated a Naval Aviator in 1996. He earned a Masters in National Security and Strategic Studies Degree from the U.S. Naval War College in 2007 and a International MBA from Thunderbird University in 2011. In 2013, he completed Federal Executive Fellowship with the Fletcher School of Law & Diplomacy at TUFTS University.

Captain Carron's operational assignments include Helicopter Combat Support Squadron FOUR(HC-4) in Sicily (2 tours), Helicopter Combat Support Squadron FIVE (HC-5) in Guam, and a command tour at Helicopter Sea Combat Squadron THREE (HSC-3) in San Diego, CA. He has over 3,800 flight hours in the MH-60S, MH-53E, unmanned, and fixed wing aircraft. Captain Carron also completed a ground deployment to Iraq in support of a Special Operations Task Force. Captain Carron is

currently the Commodore at Helicopter Sea Combat Wing Pacific fleeting up from Deputy Commodore in February, 2019.
