## A. BUPERSINST 1510.106B

1. TRANSITION, FORMERLY PROJECT TRANSITION, IS A PROGRAM INITIATED BY THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE IN RESPONSE TO THE PRESIDENT'S APRIL 1967 MANPOWER MSG TO CONGRESS. THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THIS PROGRAM IS TO ASSIST SEPARATING MILITARY PERSONNEL IN THEIR TRANSITION TO A CIVILIAN OCCUPATION. THE PROGRAM CONSISTS OF FOUR BASIC SERVICES: COUNSELING, EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE, JOB REFERRAL/PLACEMENT ASSISTANCE AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING. IN MOST CASES SKILLS ATTAINED IN THE MILITARY ARE HIGHLY OR SUBSTANTIALLY RELATED TO CIVILIAN JOBS. THEREFORE, THE MAJORITY OF SEPARATING PERSONNEL REQUIRE ONLY REPEAT COUNSELING AND ASSISTANCE.



5. WEEKLY NEWSGRAM FROM CHINFO (22-72): THE MINING OF NORTH VIETNAM'S HARBORS HAS BEEN "VERY EFFECTIVE" AND HAS "RADICALLY" REDUCED ENEMY OPPOSITION TO SEVENTH FLEET SHIPS AND PLANES, ACCORDING TO THE FORMER SEVENTH FLEET COMMANDER, VICE ADMIRAL WILLIAM MACK. AT A PENTAGON NEWS CONFERENCE JUNE 8, ADMIRAL MACK SAID THE FLEET CAN DO WHATEVER IS NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN THE MINEFIELD, WHICH HE CALLED "VERY EFFECTIVE: WE LOOK AT IT ALL THE TIME...WE DON'T SEE ANY MOVEMENT THROUGH IT." BECAUSE OF THE MINING, ADMIRAL MACK SAID, ENEMY OPPOSITION HAS BEEN "DROPPING OFF RADICALLY." IN THE FIRST DAYS AFTER THE MINING OPERATION, GUNFIRE SUPPORT SHIPS ENCOUNTERED HEAVY RETURN FIRE; ADMIRAL MACK SAID IT SEEMED THAT EVERYTHING "INCLUDING THE KITCHEN SINK WAS COMING OUT AND DROPPING AROUND US." NOW, THE ADMIRAL EXPLAINED, THERE ARE "PRETTY SMALL SINKS AND NOT MANY OF THEM." ASKED IF THE REDUCED FUEL FLOW INTO NORTH VIETNAM HAS AFFECTED ENEMY MIG OPERATIONS, THE ADMIRAL REPLIED, "THEY'RE BEING AFFECTED MOSTLY BY NAVY F-4'S." HE SAID THAT DURING APRIL AND MAY, NAVY F-4'S DOWNED EIGHT MIGS FOR EVERY NAVY AIRCRAFT LOST TO MIGS.
