I recommend the following five air crewmen for CAC wings. They flew combat search and rescue missions with me while attached to HC-1, Det-5 while deployed on various frigates and cruisers in the Tonkin Gulf off North Vietnam from January 1966 to July 1966. I can personally attest to their skills and courage under enemy fire while performing aircrew duties on combat search and rescue missions. I do not have written proof of their individual feats because the rescue reports and end of cruise report was classified and I was not graced with a copy. I did several briefings for joint service personnel in the Pentagon after completion of the cruise and these air crewmen were in the forefront of all those briefings. Enlisted Aircrewmen:
