LIEUTENANT JUNIOR GRADE WILLIAM J. WALSH UNITED STATES NAVAL RESERVE

for service as set forth in the following

CITATION:

For meritorious achievement in aerial flight as the co-pilot of an H-46D Aircraft while attached to Helicopter Combat Support Squadron FIVE Detachment THREE onboard USNS CONCORD (T AFS 5) deployed with Commander, U.S. FIFTH Fleet on 17 February 2002 in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM. Lieutenant Junior Grade Walsh's helicopter experienced an engine failure while performing a post maintenance functional hover check flight at sea. As he approached a hover altitude of 50 feet, the aircraft performance started to deteriorate. He then notified the crew of the power loss and immediately began a descending turn to the water and into the wind to control rapidly decaying rotor speed. At ten feet above the water, he relinquished flight controls to the Aircraft Commander, started the auxiliary power unit and activated the fuel jettison system to enhance single engine flight capability. Single engine power was insufficient to maintain altitude and the aircraft impacted water losing watertight integrity. His quick action of the emergency procedures and restart checklist resulted in the successful re-light of the failed engine, lift off from the water and a safe recovery on deck USNS Concord (T AFS 5). By his skillful airmanship, steadfast aggressiveness and exemplary devotion to duty in the face of hazardous flying conditions, Lieutenant Junior Grade Walsh reflected great credit upon himself and upheld the highest traditions of the United States Naval Service.
